This call is directed at organizations (public or private), businesses, institutions, research centers, business groups, integrated enterprises, non-government organizations (NGO's), chambers of commerce that are currently registered in the National Register of Scientific and Technological Firms and Institutions (RENIECYT). These parties must be interested in developing projects related to Nationally Appropriate Mitigation Actions (NAMAs) and submit proposals to develop executive projects for high impact mitigation of GHG emissions that are profitable and, that in addition to financing, require the elimination of barriers that limit their implementation.
